Welcome and Introductions

Mr. Doug Moorman was the chairperson in the absence of Steve Stevens. We each introduced ourselves and our sponsoring organization.

Petroleum Presentation

Mr. Rick Wajda and Mr. Bill Schedel gave a presentation on Fuels. The presentation focused on emissions in relation to the fuel that is burned. A discussion on Ethanol benefits vs. Non-benefits was held. Fuel regulatory developments were outlined and issues to consider in development of the SIP were highlighted. Ohio has some very singular regional considerations because of the geography that make up this region. Desulphurization cannot be counted toward the SIP but ought to be considered because of the fuel standard.

Mobile source emissions are declining as a result of a new federal fuel and vehicle standards. Selection of control measures should be limited to those determined to be necessary, timely and cost effective. Studies are underway to help assess the availability and cost effectiveness of various fuel options.

Next Steps

A full consortium group meeting is planned for January and a presentation to the OKI Board in February. The material covered would be the Air Quality in relation to the SIP and transportation strategies and stationery sources of pollution that would need to be addressed before our area can reach attainment.
