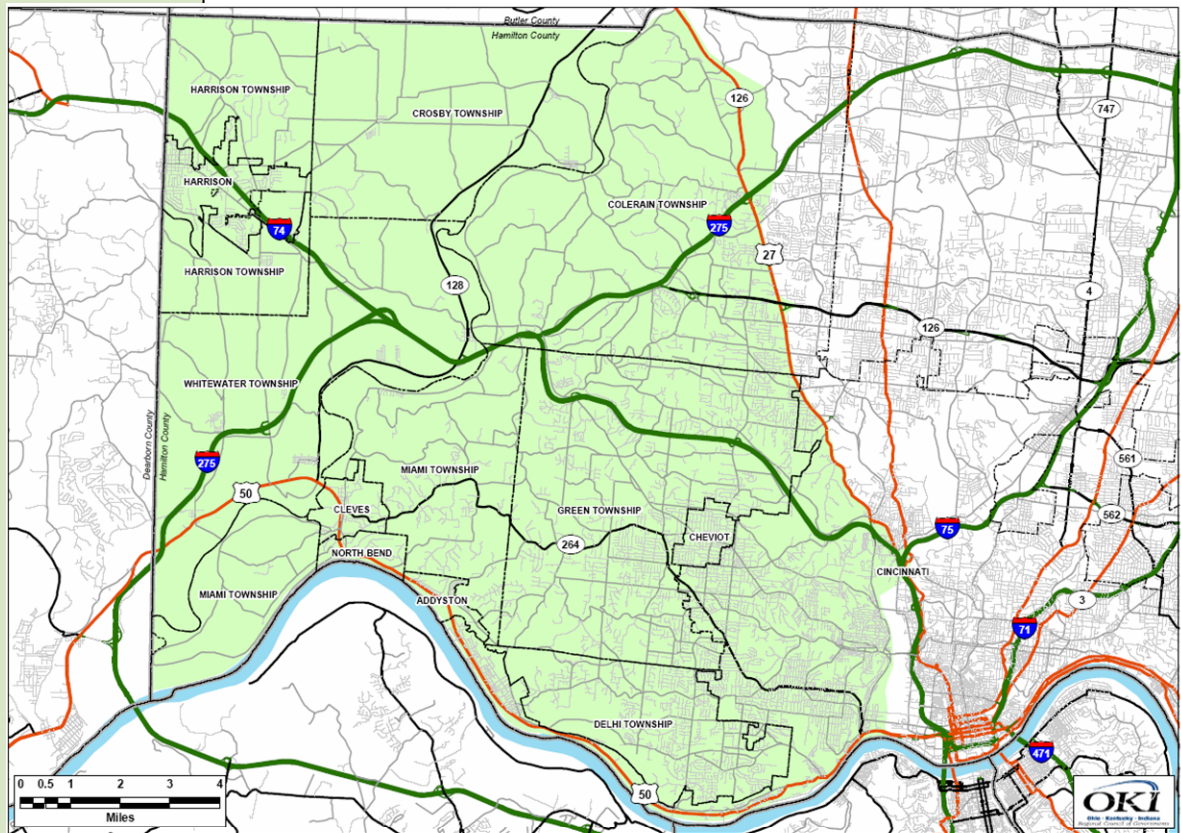


SECTION 3 - STUDY AREA

The Study Area was well defined to be the entire western portion of Hamilton County from Colerain Avenue (U.S. 27) and the Mill Creek, west to the Ohio/Indiana State line, south to the Ohio River and north to the Hamilton/Butler County line as identified in **Figure 3-1** below.

The Study Area consists of about 178 square miles. The year 2000 Census revealed that the Study Area consisted of approximately 253,000 people; approximately one-third of Hamilton County’s population.
